




Drought Severity Indicators

 - Economic


Natural Streamflow in Denver Water's Collection System



Drought Response Program Elements

Trees, shrubs and perennials	May be watered by hand-held hose or low-volume non-spray on any day, not between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.	May be watered by hand-held hose or low-volume non-spray on any day, not between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.	May be watered by hand-held hose or low-volume non-spray on any day, not between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.	Existing trees and shrubs may be watered by means of a hand-held hose or low-volume non-spray irrigation no more than once per week on scheduled day.	Not allowed, or use of hand-held hose or low-volume spray may be limited to no more than one assigned day per month.
